**Articles of Incorporation signed by Gwen Lachelt and Travis Stills 1997** - Mark Pearson – is currently the director of the San Juan Citizens Alliance. He started April 2017 to present and also prior he was the Executive Director from 2000 to 2009. Prior Directors are Dan Oleson, Dan Randolph and Megan Graham - August 2009 to March 2011. All have had Thinking Green columns, most recent column on 1-22-2017 topic Land Use Code. Megan Graham was with the Durango Herald 2006 to April 2016 – and was involved with Colorado Environmental Coalition January 200 to December 2005. Josh Joswick, former mayor of Bayfield, from 1988-1993, and La Plata County commissioner from 1993-2005 worked as an Energy Issues Organizer from 2006 to 2012. Wally White, former County Commissioner, just finished serving on their Board of Directors. Bruce Baizel has also been part of the San Juan Citizens Alliance

**Articles of Incorporation by Gwen Lachelt and Travis Stills – Gwen was Director from 1-1999 to December 2012** – this group is now known as Earthworks – Josh Joswick a community organizer along with Bruce Baizel, the current Energy Director for Earthworks and Peter Dronkers both who reside in Durango; the majority of this organization is in Washington D.C. Lauren Pagel joined Earthworks full time in August 2002 and she currently serves on the Western Leaders Network board with Elise Jones.

Elise Jones Executive Director from October 1999 to November 2012, currently she is County Commissioner for Boulder County – from 1-2013 and in her second term. She is on the board of Western Leaders Network

**Articles of Incorporation by Gwen Lachelt and Mark Pearson.** Staff included Gwen Lachelt and Mark Pearson, but now just includes Gwen Lachelt and Jessica Pace. Three of the five board members are Elise Jones (Boulder County and former Colorado Environmental Coalition), Lauren Pagel (Earthworks) and Don Schreiber, a rancher that testified as a local resident for the Martinez amicus brief – a motion made by Gwen Lachelt to enter into a lawsuit with Boulder County failed due to a lack of a second. She did not disclose that she was on staff – only admitted to starting this non-profit
